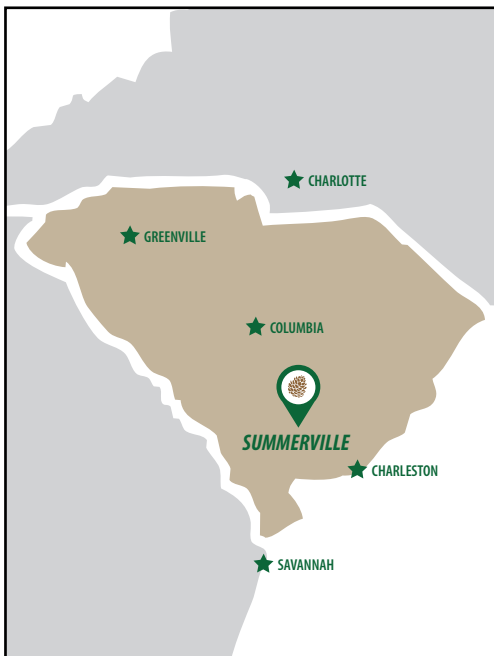




TOWN ADMINISTRATOR
